

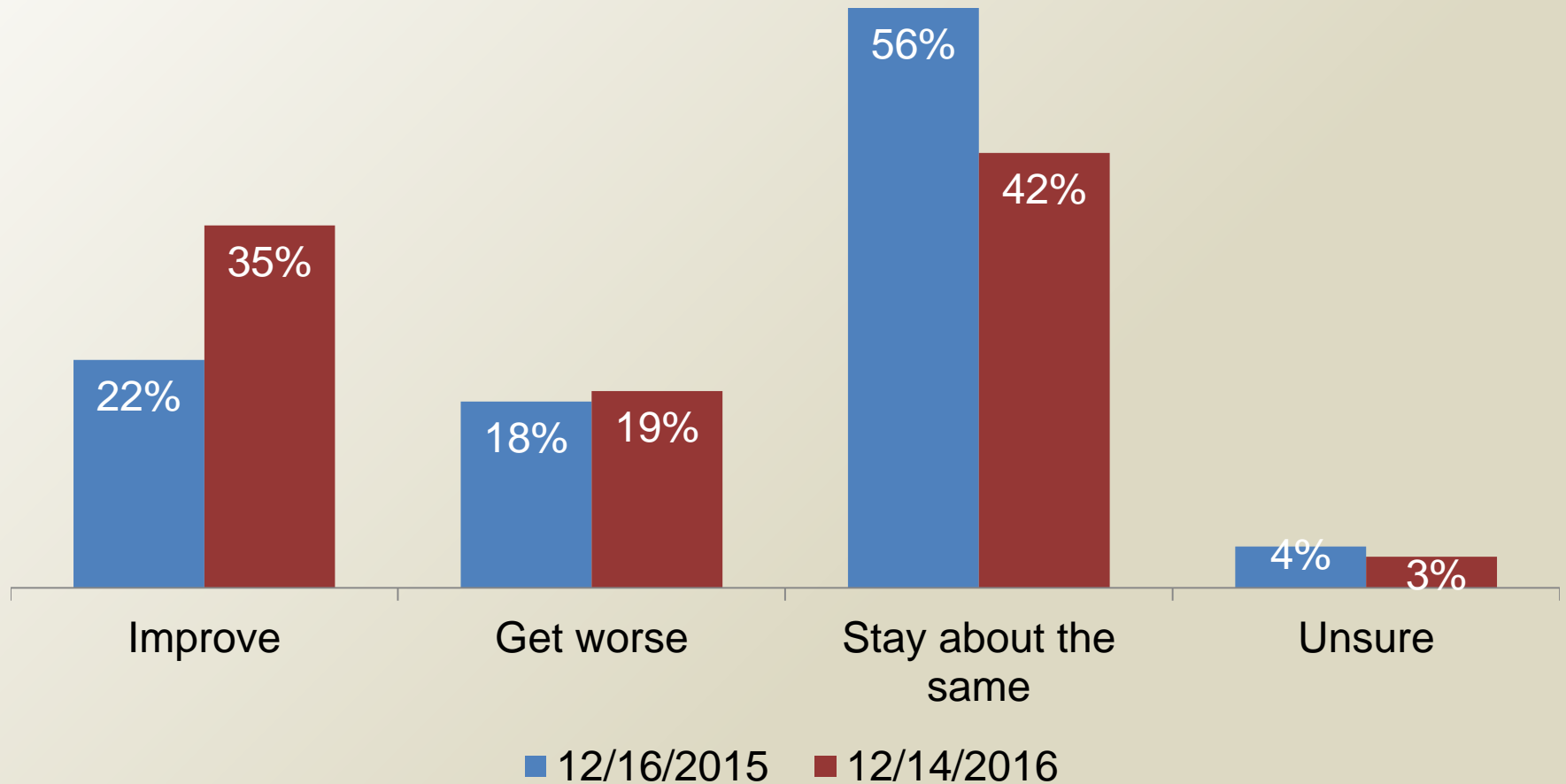

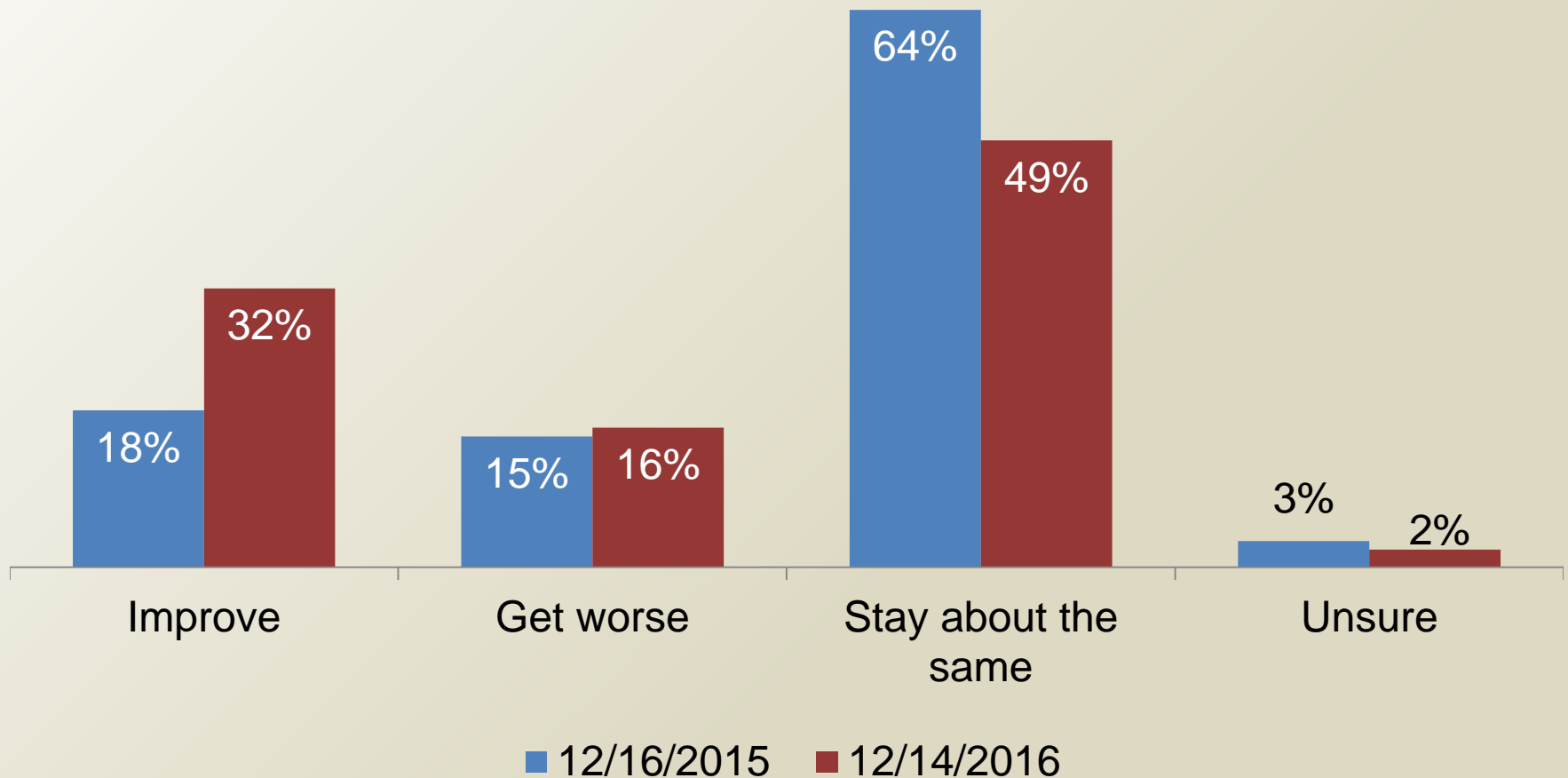

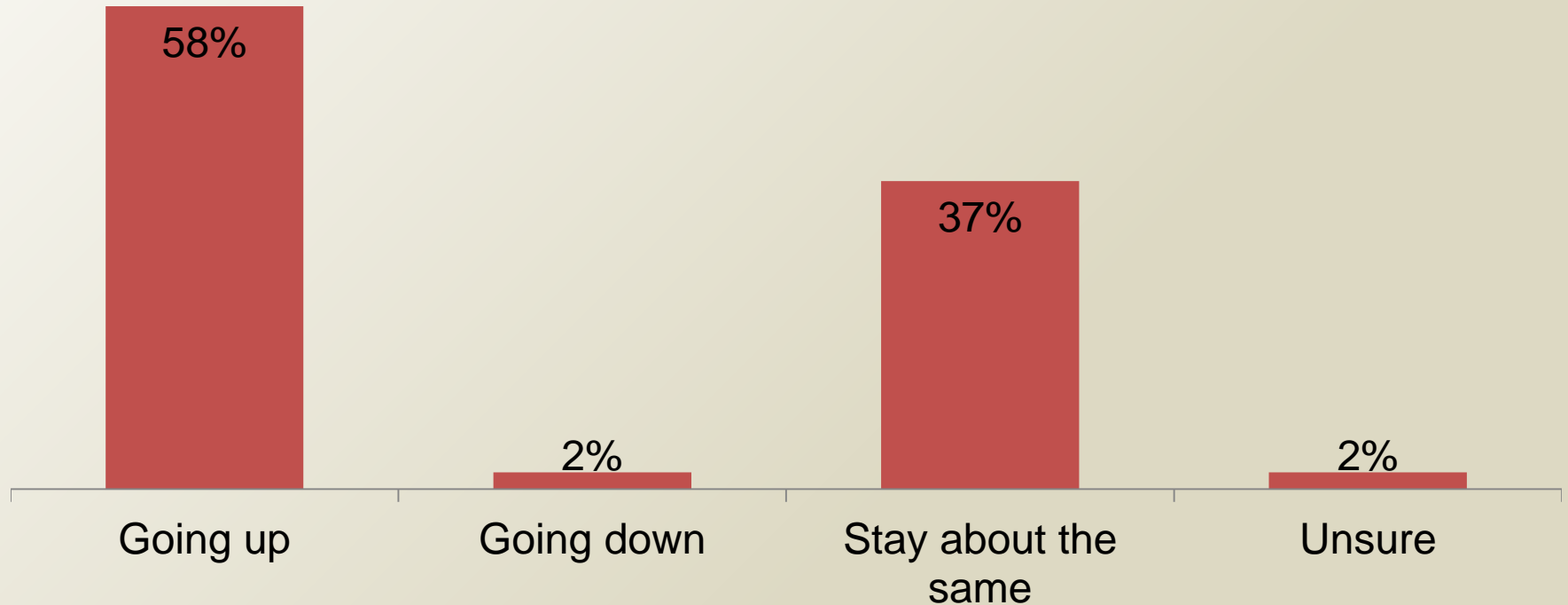
Which of the following would you say most closely describes your view of what the Wisconsin state economy will do in 2017?
Would you say that the state economy will:



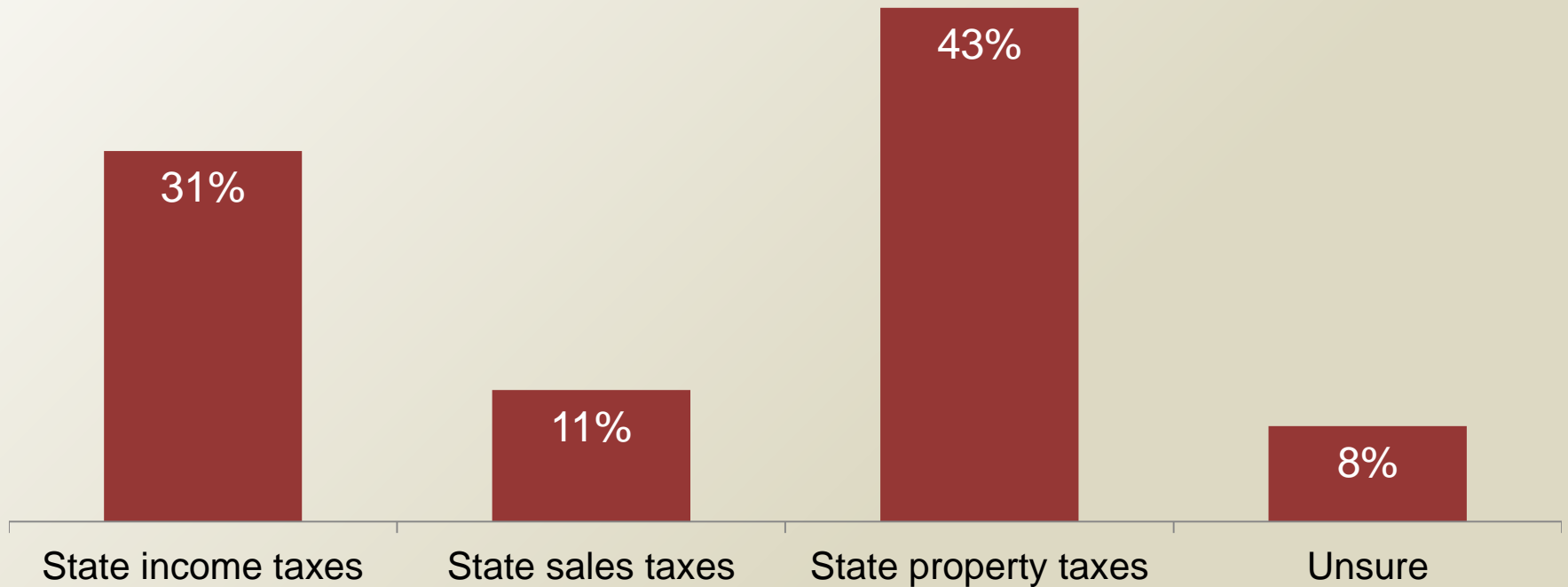
Which of the following would you say most closely describes your view of what will happen to your personal economic situation in 2017? Do you think that your personal economic situation will:



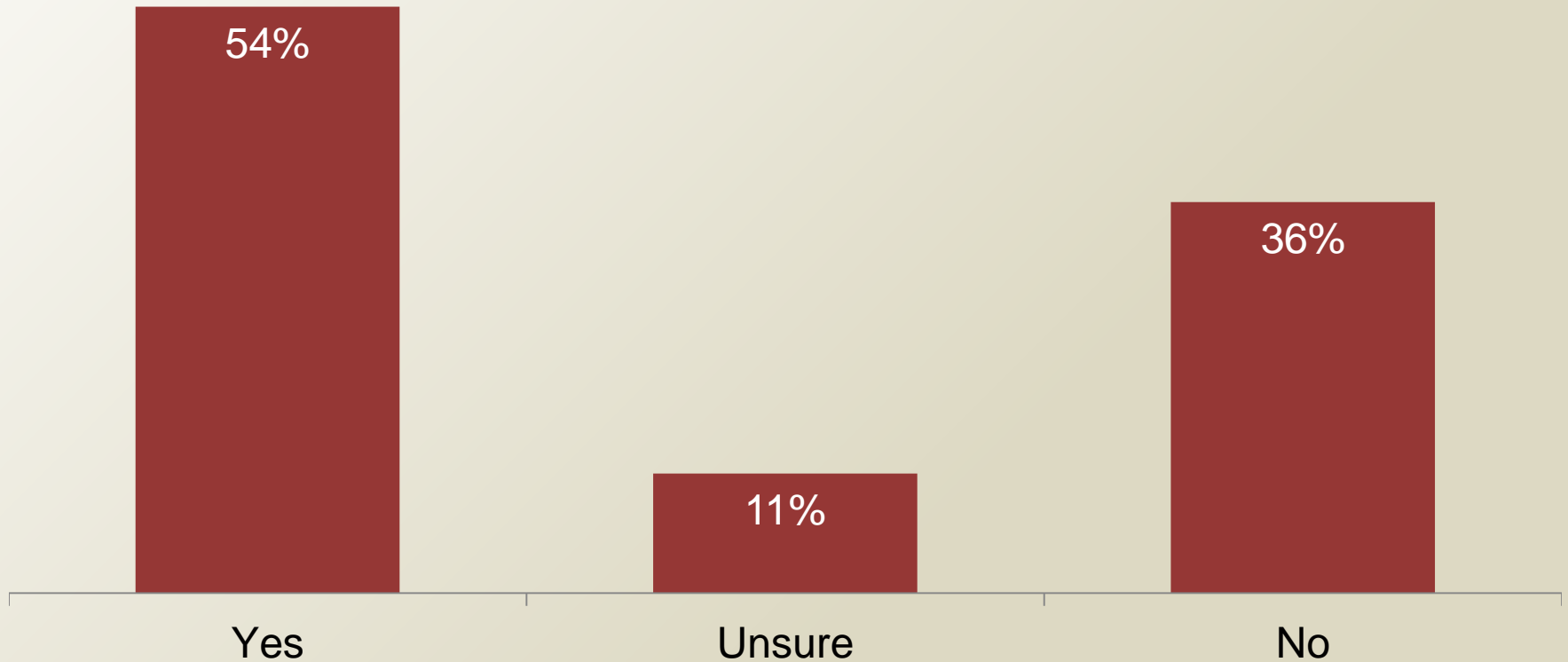
Would you say that over the last year you and your immediate family's health care costs are going up, going down, or have stayed about the same?



If the state legislature was going to consider cutting taxes, would you want them to focus on cutting...state income taxes, state sales taxes, or state property taxes?

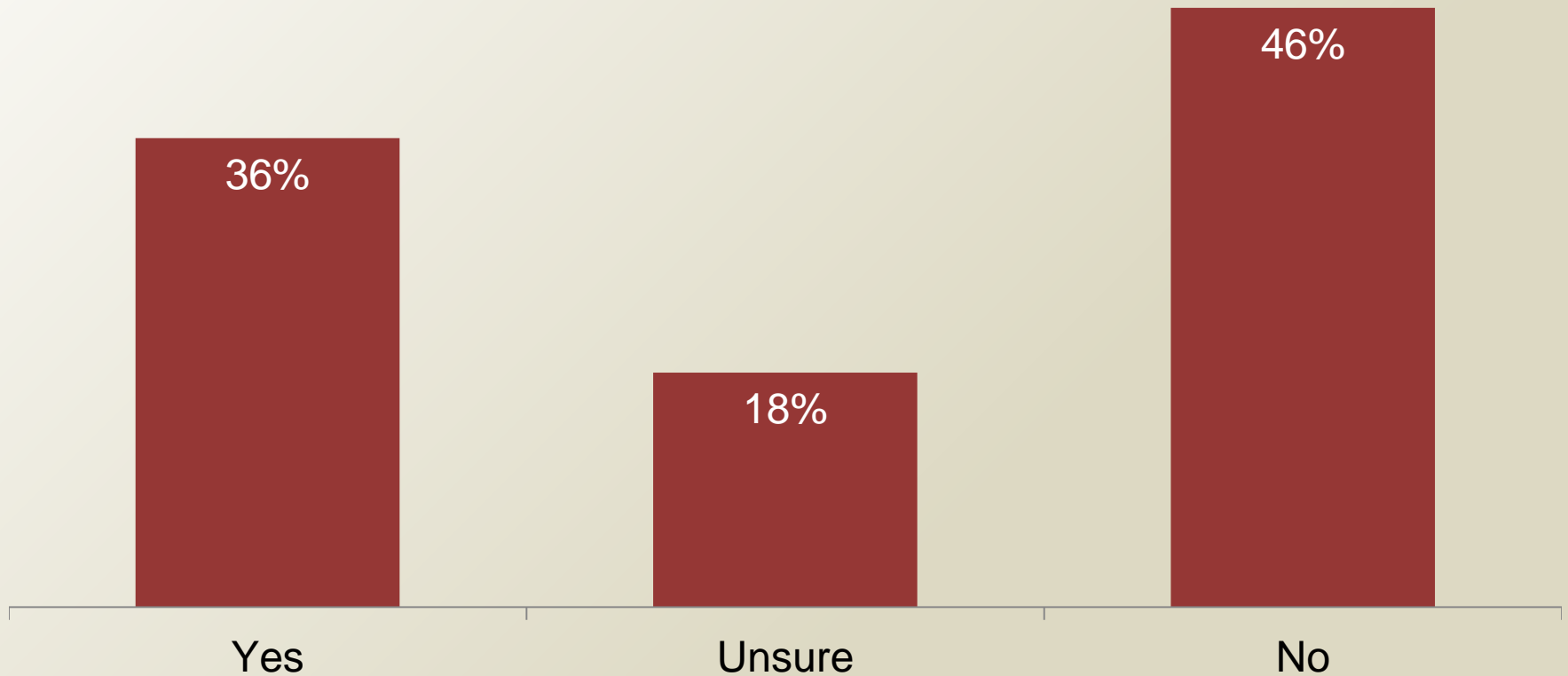


Do you believe that public schools here in Wisconsin are doing a good job of preparing students to be successful after graduation?

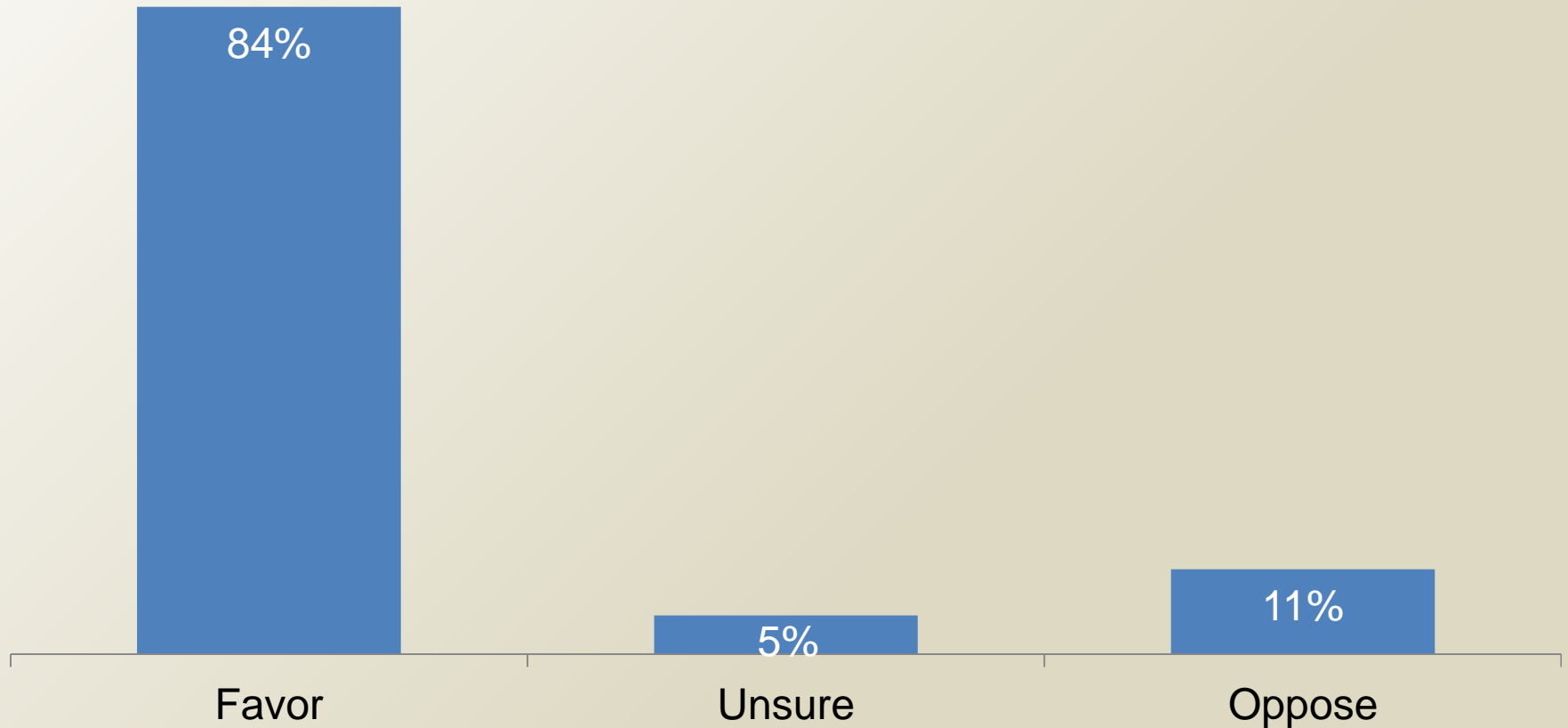

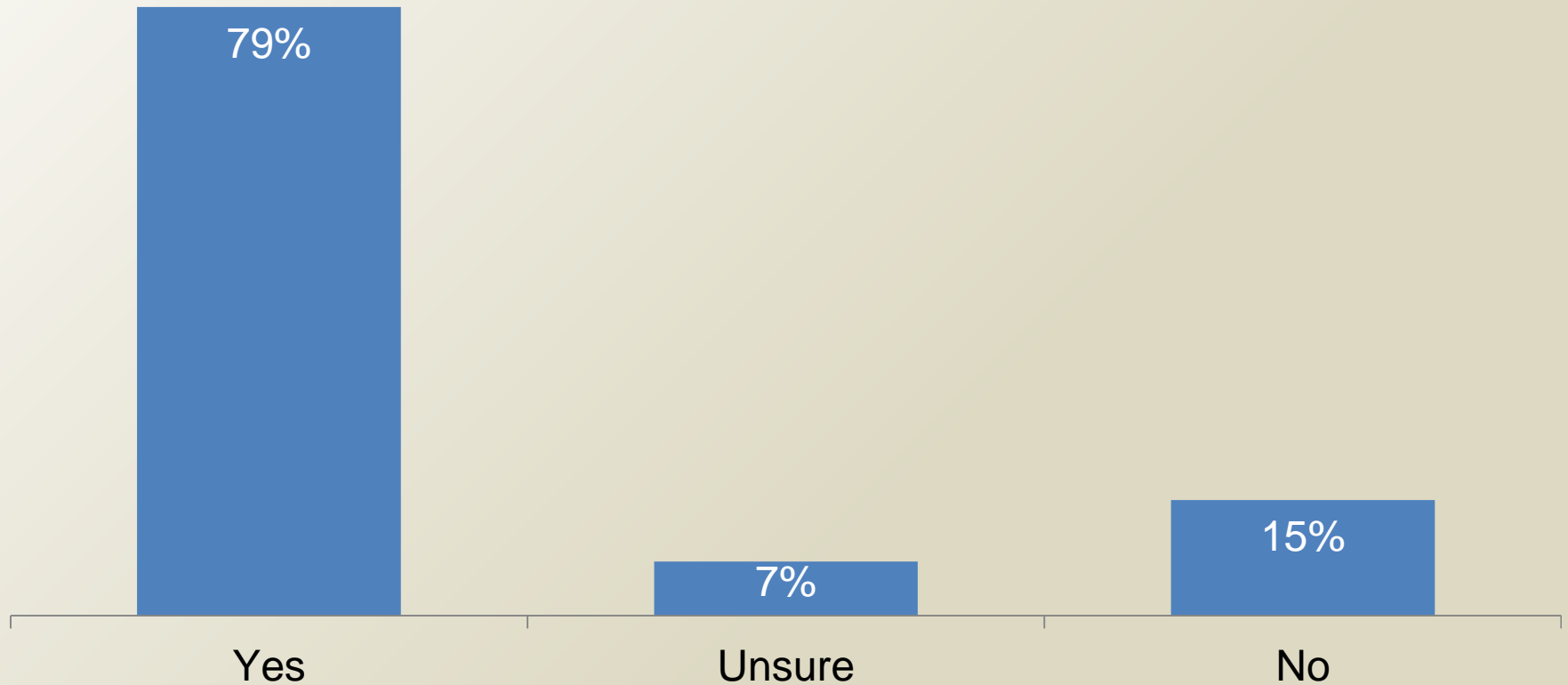
Do you believe that public schools here in Wisconsin are doing a good job of preparing students to be successful after graduation?



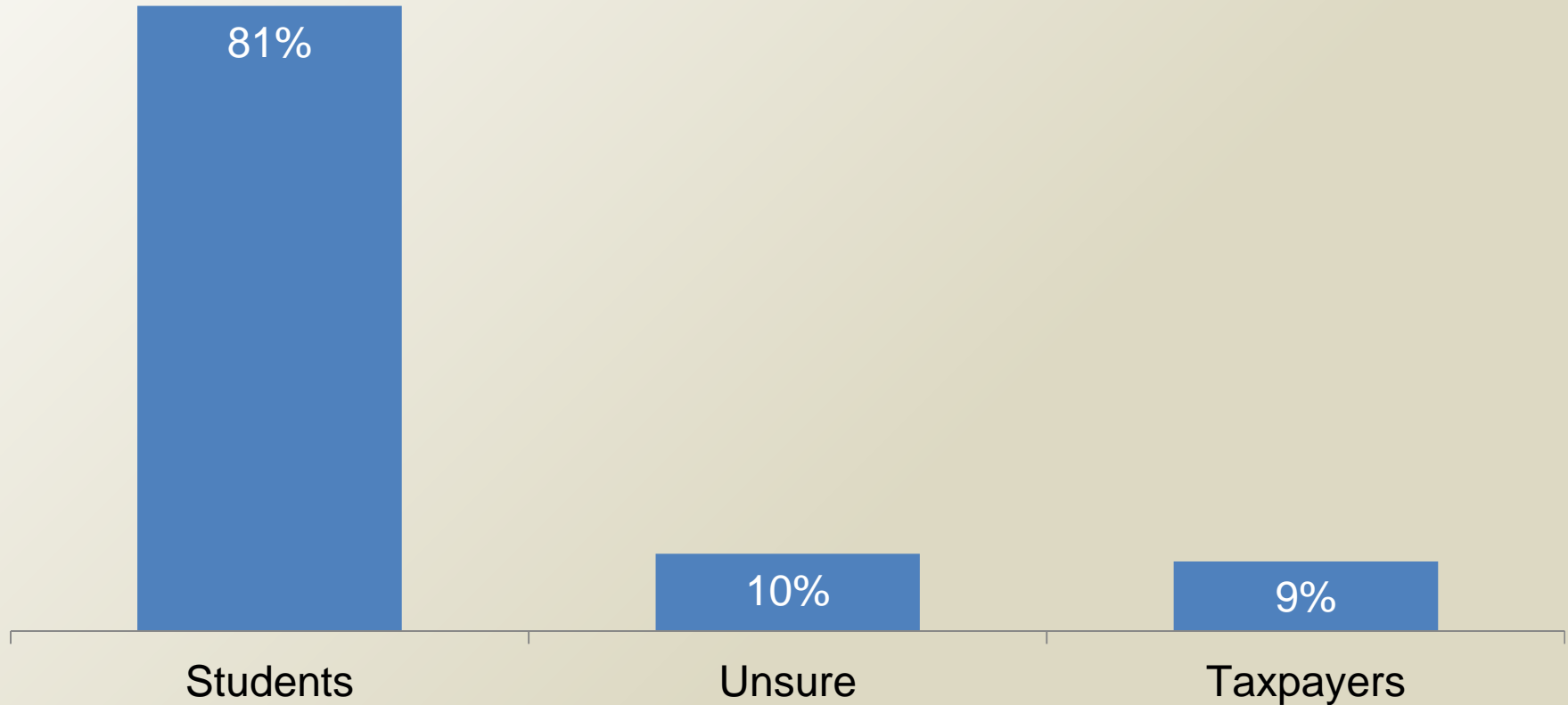
Would you favor or oppose giving schools financial incentives to provide internships, apprenticeships, or job shadowing with local businesses as part of their coursework?



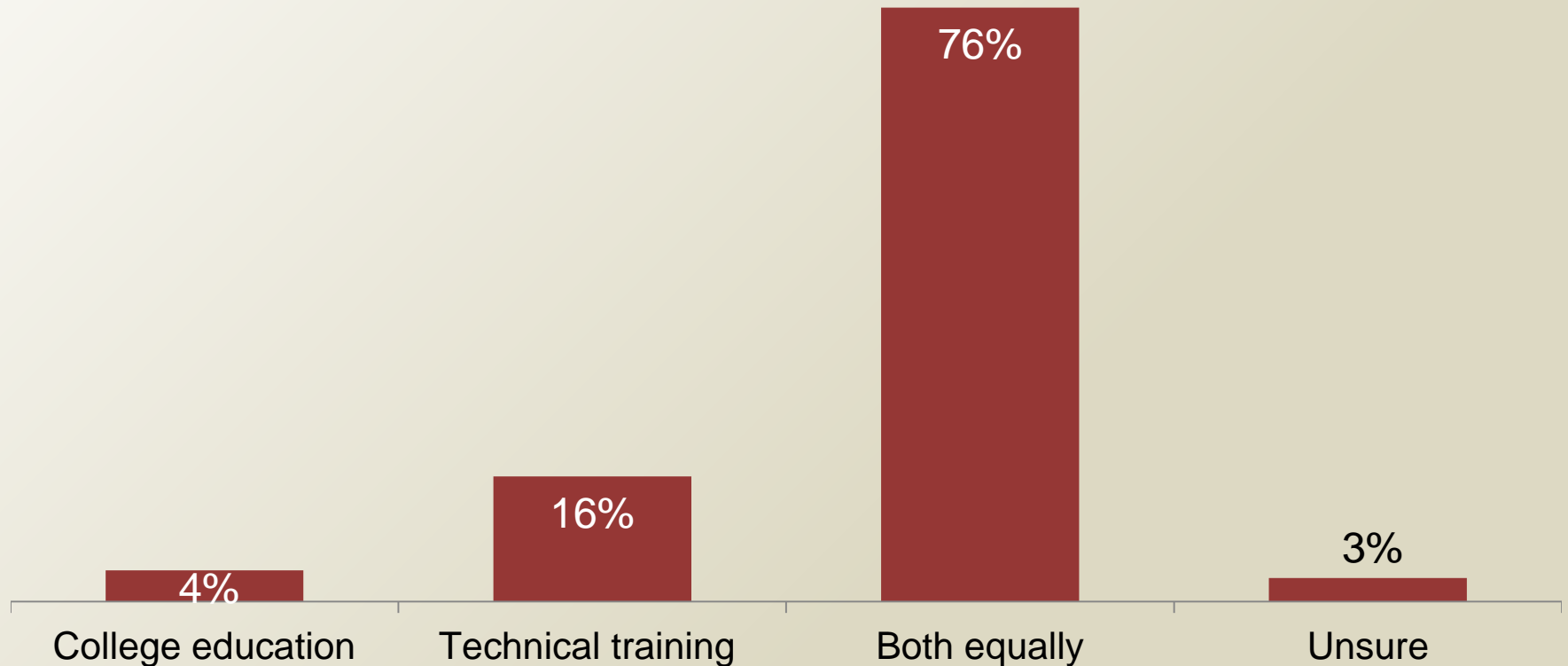
Do you support giving parents the choice to decide which school their child attends?



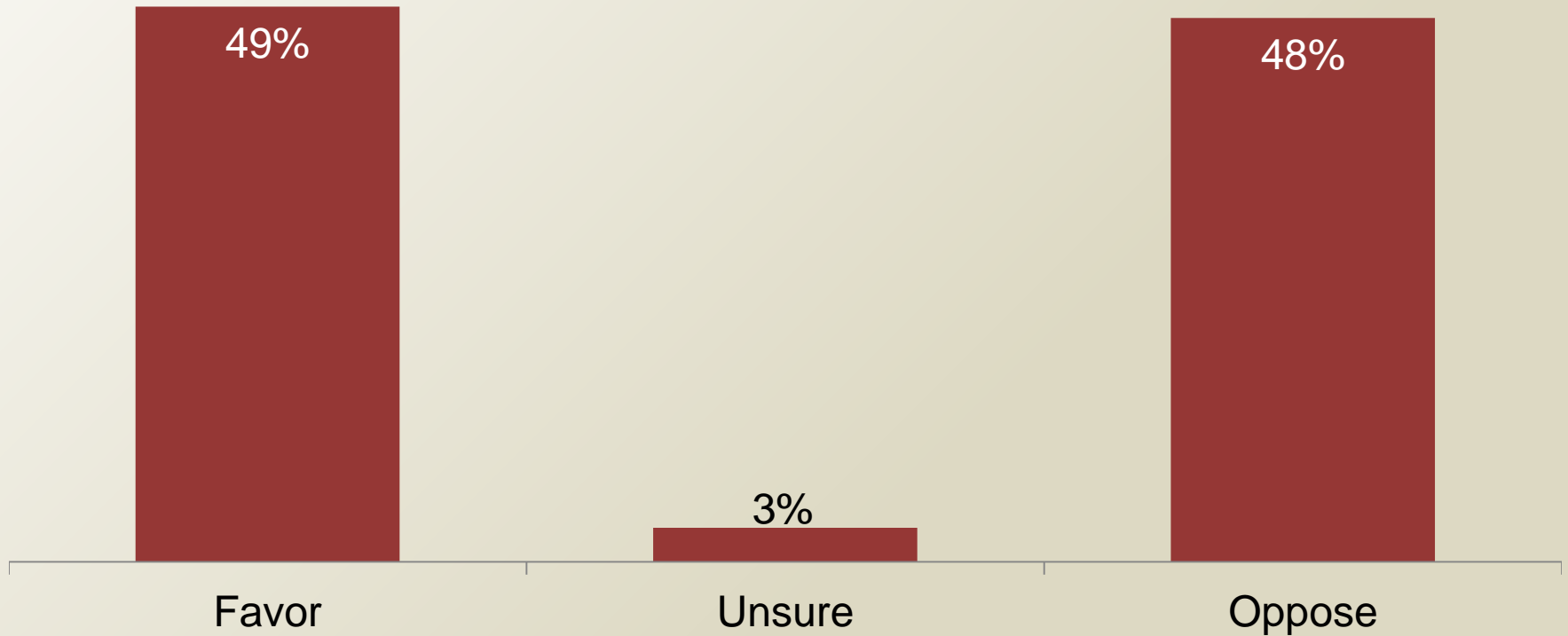
Who do you believe should be responsible for repaying student loan debt -- the students who borrowed the money OR taxpayers?



When setting priorities for spending on higher education, should the Wisconsin state legislature place a stronger focus on funding for four year degrees, funding for technical college training , or both equally?

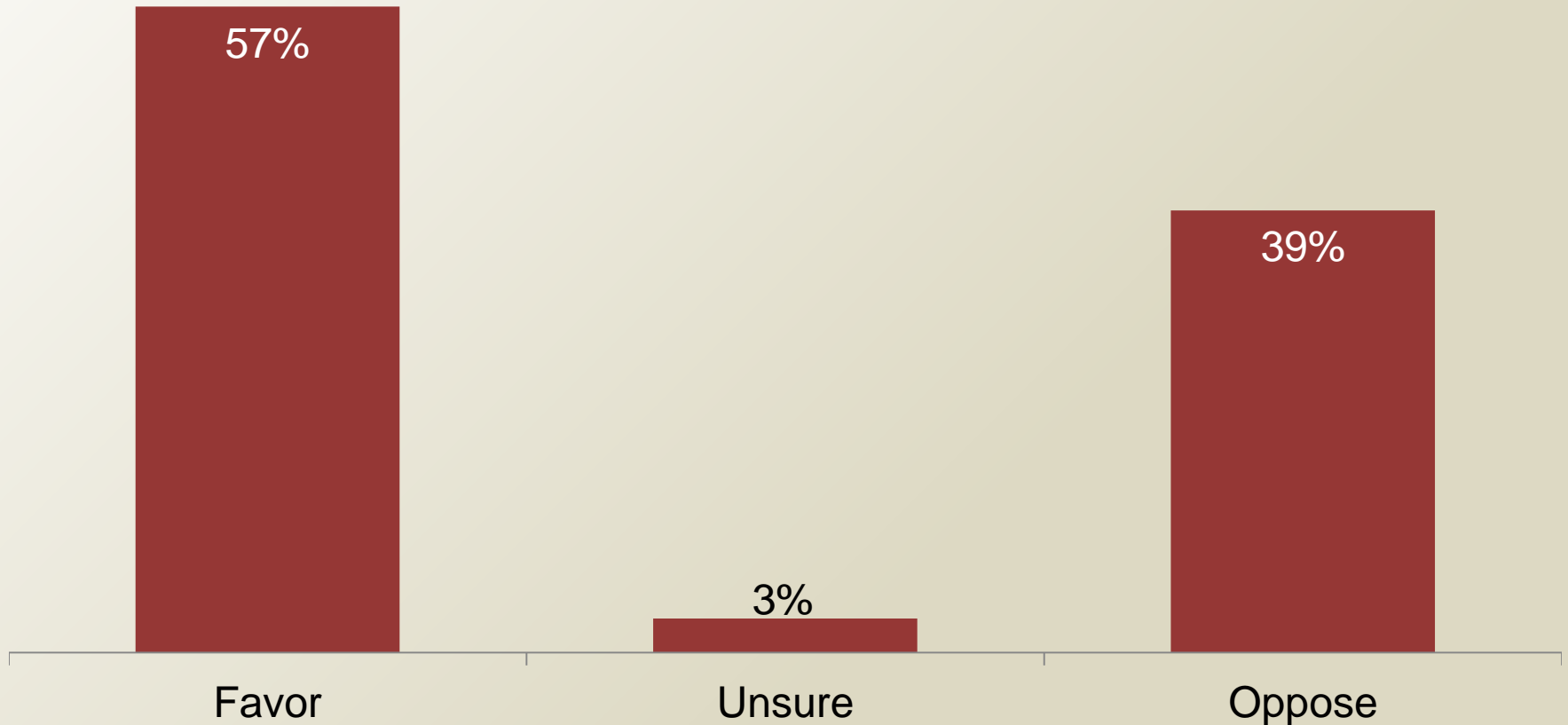


Would you favor or oppose a gas tax increase of five cents per gallon to pay for highway projects and the upkeep of roads?



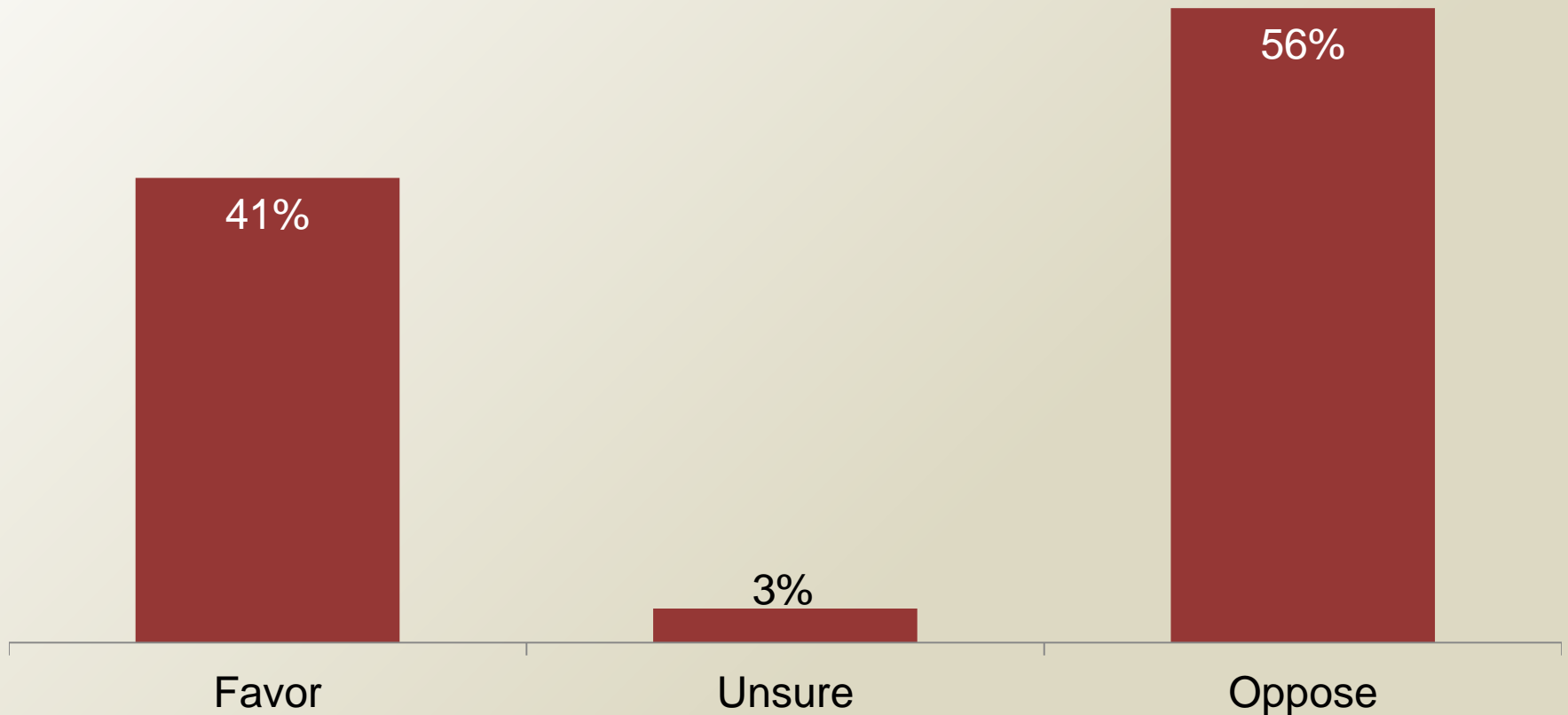

Would you favor or oppose a gas tax increase of five cents per gallon to pay for highway projects and the upkeep of roads?

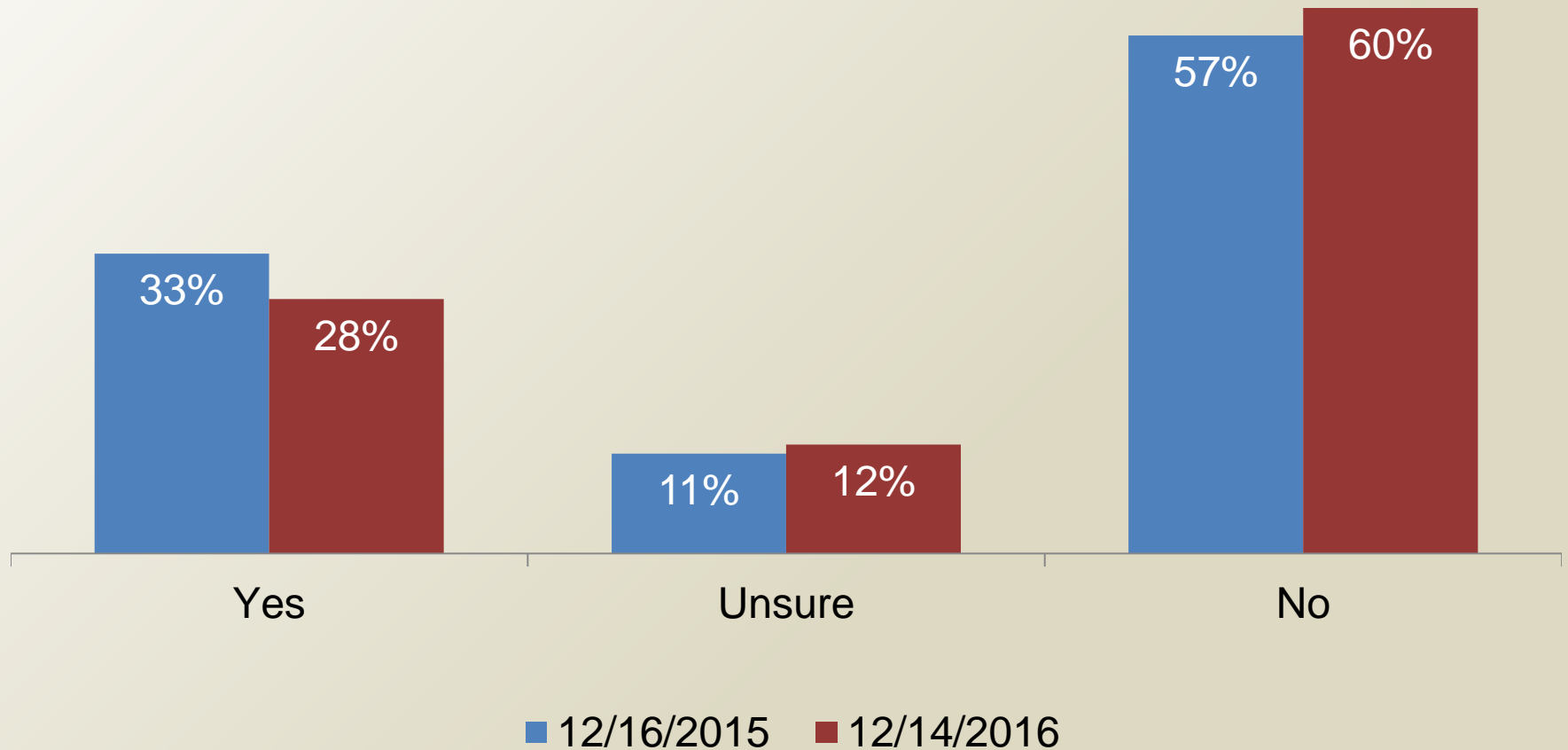


(Republicans)
