

RE: Complaint Request for Investigation

To Whom it May Concern:

I have information of possible misconduct on the part of Judge Rebecca Dallet of the Circuit Court in Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, and I submit the following as a complaint and request for investigation.

Beginning on or about March 30, 2018 and continuing through today, Judge Rebecca Dallet, through her campaign committee ("Dallet for Justice"), caused to be published certain audio and video advertisements appearing on various mediums including social media websites and radio stations.

Attached to this complaint and request for investigation are transcripts of the radio and video advertisements from Judge Rebecca Dallet's campaign. Also enclosed is a thumb drive containing electronic copies of those advertisements.

Additionally, attached to this request for investigation is a transcript of the WMC Issues Mobilization Council's (WMC IMC) video advertisement, which is referenced to and shown in Judge Rebecca Dallet's video advertisement. A video copy of that advertisement is included on the enclosed thumb drive.

It is unknown how many people have seen or heard the ads that were, and still are to the best of my knowledge, publicly available.

Judge Rebecca Dallet has knowingly and with reckless disregard for the truth or falsity of her statements, misrepresented facts concerning her opponent in her campaign for Justice of the Supreme Court in violation of the Wisconsin Code of Judicial Conduct, SCR 60.06(3)(c):

60.06(3)(c) Misrepresentations. A candidate for a judicial office shall not knowingly or with reckless disregard for the statement's truth or falsity misrepresent the identity, qualifications, present position, or other fact concerning the candidate or an opponent. A candidate for judicial office should not knowingly make representations that, although true, are misleading, or knowingly make statements that are likely to confuse the public with respect to the proper role of judges and lawyers in the American adversary system

Specifically, Judge Dallet has published campaign advertisements that are false. In a video advertisement, her campaign shows an advertisement paid for by WMC-IMC and claims "Michael Screnock's ads are false." WMC IMC is not affiliated with any candidate or candidate's committee and does not engage in express advocacy related to elections. Judge

Dallet has misrepresented WMC IMC's advertisement as that of Judge Michael Screnock, her opponent.


WMC IMC's advertisement does not, in any way, mention Judge Michael Screnock. Moreover, while Judge Dallet's video advertisement labels WMC IMC's advertisement as "FALSE," and includes quotes from both Milwaukee County Deputy District Attorney Patrick J. Kenney and Judge Rebecca Dallet accusing that ad of being false.

WMC IMC's ad is not false. The advertisement pulled every piece of information from public records, which are documented and verifiable. Judge Rebecca Dallet's assertions are not, and cannot be, substantiated.

Per Wis. Stat. § 757.81(4)(a), a "Willful violation of a rule of the code of judicial ethics" is misconduct. Judge Rebecca Dallet knowingly and falsely accuses her opponent of running an advertisement, and then knowingly and falsely accuses that advertisement of being false and has a Deputy District Attorney re-iterate the same claim. Judge Rebecca Dallet's knowingly false and misleading ad is a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct.

For the foregoing reasons I hereby request an investigation into this matter.

**Transcript: Dallet for Justice Video Advertisement (electronic file on enclosed thumb drive as "DalletVideo.mp4")**

Patrick J. Kenney, Milwaukee County Deputy District Attorney: "When you're running for our highest court, you should have your facts straight. (*advertisement begins showing clips of WMC-IMC advertisement, with the word "FALSE" overlaid*) Michael Screnock's ads are false. I know, I was the prosecutor in the case that they're lying about. Judge Rebecca Dallet made sure that justice was served."

Judge Rebecca Dallet: "As a mother of three daughters, and a prosecutor and a judge for twenty years, I've delivered justice to victims of rape and child abuse. These attack ads are lying."

Patrick J. Kenney, Milwaukee County Deputy District Attorney: "Judge Rebecca Dallet, she will serve with integrity."

**Transcript: Dallet for Justice Radio Advertisement (electronic file on enclosed thumb drive as "DalletAudio.mp4")**

Patrick J. Kenney, Milwaukee County Deputy District Attorney: "When you're running for Wisconsin's highest court, you better have your facts straight. The ads for Michael Screnock are false. I know because I am prosecutor Pat Kenney and I prosecuted the case they're lying about. Judge Rebecca Dallet made sure justice was served."

Judge Rebecca Dallet: "As a mother of three daughters, and a prosecutor and a judge for twenty years, I've delivered justice to victims of rape and child abuse. These attack ads are lying."

Patrick J. Kenney, Milwaukee County Deputy District Attorney: "Wisconsin needs a Supreme Court Justice who serve with integrity that is fair and impartial and who puts victims first. A justice who stands up to the special interests and protects our rights. But facts are facts and ads for Michael Screnock have the facts wrong, join me and vote for Judge Rebecca Dallet on April 3."

Other voice: "Paid for by Dallet for Justice."

**Transcript: WMC IMC Video Advertisement (with sources noted) (electronic file on enclosed thumb drive as "WMCIMCVideo.mp4")**

Narrator: "Three-time felon Donald Skenandore was arrested for sexually assaulting his 7 and 8 year-old granddaughters... a nightmare that lasted 6 years. (Source: *Skenandore Sentencing Transcript pg.24: 2-20*)

Judge Rebecca Dallet knew Skenandore repeatedly assaulted his grandchildren (Source: *Skenadore Sentencing Transcript pg. 25:16-21*), but then she said "there wasn't an extreme amount of harm" because there was no intercourse. (Source: *Skenandore Sentencing Transcript pg.25:23-24*)

Dallet could have sentenced Skenandore to 20 years. But she gave him only two. (Source: *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*, "Wisconsin Supreme Court candidate Rebecca Dallet gave man 2 years in prison for attempted child sex assault," January 30, 2018.
